What is Topten?

Topten is an online search tool which presents the best appliances in various categories of products. The key criteria are energy efficiency, impact on the environment, health and quality. Topten provides an independent and transparent list of products based on these criteria and is updated regularly.

Topten was launched in 2000 in Switzerland. Since then, fifteen other national Topten sites have been established, stretching across the EU. This development has been made possible by funding received from Intelligent Energy Europe for the Topten and Topten Plus projects.

Topten Pro

Topten Pro is aimed at supporting public authorities and other professional buyers in the procurement of highly efficient products by:

- Providing detailed guidance for the purchase of energy-efficient products which is updated regularly to meet the latest Topten standards
- Providing sample tender documents incorporating specifications, criteria and a life-cycle costing approach for each product group, which may be adapted for use by individual public authorities
- Offering direct assistance to public authorities and professional buyers who are interested in applying the Topten approach to purchase highly-efficient products
